The candidate must be a team player (with a sense of humour!) and help administrate and facilitate various projects and performances. Experience in relevant theatre and arts projects is needed. They should have excellent organisational skills including the ability to work calmly under pressure as well as the ability to juggle multiple tasks and prioritise their time.
