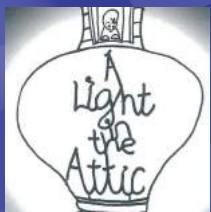

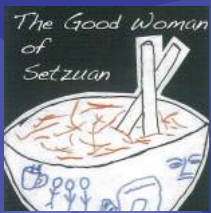
A LIGHT IN THE ATTIC

Performed by Group DB4 (actors aged 12 to 16)



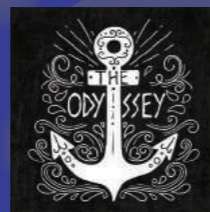
MODERN TEENAGE FABLES
