Faust's Summer Programmes offer exciting courses in Summer Theatre, Creative Writing, and Musical Theatre for children aged 3 to 15. From action-packed weeks to engaging workshops, your child will have the opportunity to boost their confidence, teamwork, and artistic skills in a safe and respectful environment. With multiple locations across Hong Kong and flexible scheduling options, it's easy to find a programme that suits your schedule.

# What to Expect at Faust!

**Action-packed weeks:** From June 24<sup>th</sup> to August 23<sup>rd</sup>, immerse yourself in week-long programmes designed to boost confidence, teamwork, and artistic skills.

**Variety of options:** Choose from our three programmes: Summer Theatre, Creative Writing, and Musical Theatre, each tailored to specific age groups and interests.

**Multiple locations:** We offer programmes in various locations across Hong Kong, Kowloon and the New Territories.

**Flexible scheduling:** Our programmes run for nine weeks, allowing you to select the weeks that suit your schedule. You can combine different courses for a full day of learning and fun!

**Showcasing achievements:** At the end of each week, children will have the opportunity to showcase their talent and hard work in performances or take home a portfolio of their written work.

Each week children will explore different aspects of the performing world by learning and practising drama skills using different themed stories as inspiration. Activities are engaging and challenging, and focus on providing children with a sense of achievement and a boost of creativity and confidence. Most importantly, our workshops are designed to be fun and enjoyable for all! Photographs and a mid-week report will be emailed to parents. Subject to government guidelines, each child can invite a guest to an end of week open session where children will share their learning.

#### **New Content Each Week**

Younger actors will focus on developing confidence using the actor's tools – the voice, body and imagination. Older actors will build upon this foundation with more complex and challenging drama skills to become more skilled performers. Scripts and themes will vary from fresh adaptations of famous stories to original, devised stories and are chosen each week with our actors in mind!

#### **Performance Skills & Knowledge**

- Expressive use of voice and vocal projection
- Creative physical movement and ability
- Being in the moment and stage awareness
- Understand different points of view and empathy
- Appreciate and understand different styles, genres, practitioners and more from the wonderful world of theatre!



Our small group courses run Monday to Friday and aim to unlock the potential of our young writers with a series of exciting writing challenges. Each day students learn different writing techniques, genres, literary tropes and more. By the end of the week, each child will build their own portfolio of work to share with parents.

#### **New Content Each Week**

Each week our writers will have new themes to inspire them. For all ages, we encourage our writers to express and develop their own ideas and stories. For younger writers we use structured schemes of work to support their writing. For older writers we present a more challenging set of exercises and explore sophisticated themes. All of our writers receive plenty of verbal and written feedback in a small group setting.

Our week-long musical theatre workshops are a great way for those interested in singing, dancing and acting to hone their skills to become triple-threat performers. Throughout the week, members will learn how to become familiar with their voice and vocal range, act out parts of a script and song, and learn choreography. This will all culminate in an open session at the end of the week where family and friends can enjoy a small musical performance, subject to government guidelines. Alternatively, a video will be filmed and emailed to parents.

#### **New Musical Numbers Each Week**

Each week we choose from a great list of great musical numbers to perform. Songs for our younger age groups could come from a range of musicals such *Matilda the Musical*, *School of Rock* and more. Older age groups will get to look at more challenging pieces from modern musicals such as *Mean Girls*, *SIX*, *Legally Blonde*, *Dear Evan Hansen* and more.

# Frequently Asked Questions

#### Can my child do Summer Theatre / Musical Theatre & Creative Writing in the same week?

Yes, as long as your child is the right age! Many children choose this option as it is a great way to get the mind and body engaged and creative! Wherever possible we schedule workshops so children can do both programmes in one day.

# What is taught in Faust's Summer Programmes?

Each week brings a different focus and theme with content tailored to the age range of the group. Parents are informed through workshop reports (Holiday Theatre) or weekly schedules (Creative Writing) of what their child is doing.

# My child is very shy. Will he or she enjoy the workshops?

Yes, our workshops are designed for shy through to confident children. Leaders work within a child's comfort zone, encouraging and supporting them.

# Does my child need to have had any drama or creative writing experience?

No, children come to workshops with different levels of experience. An interest in drama or creative writing and a fluency in English are important.

#### How can I get a discount?

We offer a Friends Together discount of 15% if you register 3 or more children with your friends. Alternatively there is a 10% early bird available if you register by May 31st. Please note that these discounts cannot be combined.

# Will I get to see what my child has accomplished?

For Summer Theatre and Musical Theatre, each child can invite a guest, friend or family member to an end of week open session subject to government guidelines.

Our younger members will share their learning and our older learners will demonstrate their skills and knowledge in an end of week performance. For Creative Writing, children bring their work home at the end of the week. Our teachers will also be happy to give you feedback about your child's progress.

# If my child joins a Faust Summer Programme can they continue with their drama lessons?

Yes, we run after school and Saturday drama workshops during term time. As a member of our Summer Programme you will be sent details of all our courses.

#### What's the policy in terms of weather?

All workshops will be cancelled in the event of Typhoon Signal No.8 or higher, or black rain warning if hoisted at 7am for morning workshops and 12noon for afternoon workshops. No refunds, make up classes or credit notes will be made in this case.
